
## The Outworking of the Cross



The problem of sin dealt with by penal sacrifice

Atonement

Sin covered God satisfied

Propitiation

God's wrath against sin turned away

Remission

Sin removed, guilt cancelled

Redemption

Payment for broken law, debtor ransomed

Reconciliation

Fellowship with God restored

Forgiveness

Deliverance from guilt See remission / justn.

God's relationship with the believer

Justification

Believer pardoned from sin, declared legally righteous, receives imputed righteousness of Christ **Definitive Sanctification** 

Made positionally righteous in Christ in heaven

Adoption

Placed in God's family with status as heir in Christ Glorification

Believer fitted for heaven with new body like Christ's body.
